

## Shirley Sports and Social Association – 100 Club Rules

1. The object of the 100 Club is to raise funds for Shirley Sports and Social Association in support of its aims.
2. The 100 Club will be run under the supervision of the Association Management Team, who will also administer it.
3. The 100 Club is open to anyone over the age of 16, but preference will be given to residents of Shirley and the surrounding area, their family and friends when allocating ticket numbers.
4. You must fill in an application form.
5. Entry will be by subscription of £20 per number per annum, paid to Shirley Sports and Social Association in advance. **We prefer payment by Standing Order.** Please *reference* your Standing Order application with:  
<your surname>-100 (e.g. "Smith-100")
6. We also accept payment by Bank Transfer, cash or cheque.
7. You may purchase more than one ticket.
8. Draws will be held quarterly. Draw dates will be published in advance on the Shirley Sports & Social Association website ([www.shirleysports.org.uk](http://www.shirleysports.org.uk)) and will appear on tickets.
9. Winners will be contacted and their names will be posted on the Shirley Sports & Social Association website each month after the draw.
10. 75% of all money raised from the Shirley Sports & Social Association 100 Club will go towards The Association's funds. The remaining 25% will be used for the 100 Club prize fund.
11. At each draw, three prizes will be awarded. *Assuming that 100 tickets are sold:*
  - a. The first three draws each year will be for £50, £25 and £25.
  - b. The final draw in each year will be for £100, £50 and £50.
  - c. Draws will be held in public in the Saracen's Head public house, Shirley on the published dates. If this is not possible, draws will be broadcast via our Facebook page.
  - d. *We reserve the right to increase or decrease the actual prize values, pro-rata, to reflect the actual number of tickets sold.*
12. Registers will be kept recording the name and address of each member, the ticket number(s) allocated to them and the subscriptions received from them.
13. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the Club if his or her renewal of subscription remains unpaid for a period of one month.
14. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into Shirley Sports & Social Association funds after 6 months.
